The County is currently accepting applications for the position of **Social Work Supervisor III (CPS)**. This position includes advanced level supervisory work in the guidance and coordination of professional personnel engaged in the social work operations of CPS Investigative and Family Assessments; assigns work to CPS Social Workers and closely monitors work for quality; coaches staff on their work; assists staff in the interpretation of regulations, procedures, and other relevant information; serves as after-hours intake and on-call supervisor on a rotating basis; and works closely with other supervisors and managers to coordinate the work of the Social Work Services Division

Requires extensive knowledge of federal, state, and county laws, regulations, guidelines and procedures involving activities supervised; considerable knowledge of social work principles, techniques and practices and their application to specific casework and community problems.

Minimum qualifications include a Master's Degree in Social Work and two years of social work or counseling experience; or a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work and three years of social work or counseling experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Degree/Coursework must be from an appropriately accredited institution. **If degree is not in Social Work, please submit a copy of college transcript with application.** A valid driver's license is required.

Starting Salary \$60,500 - \$66,600 (commensurate with experience) and excellent benefits package available.
